DISCUSSION: God's memory is...

I. Infallible.

- A. Its records are accurate.
- B. Its records are impartial.
- C. Its records are judgmental.
 - 1. "I know your works..." (Rev. 2:2, 19; 3:1, 8, 15).
 - 2. No miscarriage of justice can possibly occur.

II. Omniscient.

- A. God knows of the most obscure events as well as the most public.
- B. He knows the microscopic details of human life (Matt. 10:29, 30).
- C. He fathoms the most secret thoughts and motives (Psa. 139:3, 4).

III. Happy to be reminded.

- A. Not that He needs to be reminded
- B. Not that He wants to forget
- C. But because He loves to see His children believe and recall His word
 - 1. Men want to be trusted.
 - 2. Cf. Luke 24:25.
